

Behaviour & Anti-Bullying Policy

1. Purpose

To promote positive behaviour, emotional regulation, and respect in all learning environments — including home and virtual settings.

2. Principles

B. Education fosters therapeutic, respectful relationships between tutors and pupils. Behaviour management is rooted in empathy, consistency, and restorative approaches.

3. Expectations

- Respect for others and property.
- Safe and kind behaviour at all times.
- Punctuality and participation in learning.

4. Bullying

B. Education defines bullying as *repeated, intentional behaviour that causes physical or emotional harm.* This includes:

- Verbal, physical, or cyberbullying.
- Discrimination or exclusion based on protected characteristics.

5. Procedures

- All incidents are recorded and reported to the Designated Safeguarding Lead.
- Tutors work with parents and local authorities to develop behaviour support plans where necessary.
- Serious incidents may trigger a review of tuition arrangements.
